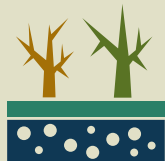
About Consultative Group for International Agricultural Research (CGIAR)

Technology/Application

Seeks to enable small-scale family farmers to access climate information that has been produced by national weather institutes, in conjunction with local weather stations.

Features of the inclusive technology solution



- Acquisition of meteorological and agroclimatic data.
- Agronomic modeling.
- Preparation of agricultural recommendations for each zone and crop, taking into account indigenous, academic and scientific knowledge.
- Preparation and dissemination of newsletters throughout the country, using media such as SMS and WhatsApp, thereby increasing the spread of scientific knowledge.
- In Honduras, it is part of the climate change policy agenda.
