Digital mobile phone application that facilitates traceability and production and financial recordkeeping, thereby contributing to more efficient and sustainable agricultural management. It focuses on small-scale farmers, seeking to provide resources and build capacities to boost profitability, environmental sustainability and socioeconomic equality in agriculture.

Features of the inclusive technology solution

The application allows farmers and organizations to:

Access electronic platforms to document and record planting and reaping dates, inputs used, costs and sales.	Analyze data to foster evidence-based decision-making.	Make calculations, record data and undertake long-term tracking of trends, without the need for an internet connection.
